- \*\*A. Overview of UTA\*\*
  - Non-profit organization dedicated to supporting Taekwondo athletes.
  - Oversees five regional associates: Great Lakes Taekwondo United (GTU), East Coast Taekwondo United (ETU), Northeast Taekwondo United (NTU), South Taekwondo United (STU), and West Taekwondo United (WTU).

  - UTA aims to unite and empower Taekwondo athletes through education, training, and financial support for local, national, and international competitions.

- \*\*A. UTA and its Associates\*\*
  - \*\*1. Great Lakes Taekwondo United (GTU)\*\*
  - \*\*2. East Coast Taekwondo United (ETU)\*\*
  - \*\*3. Northeast Taekwondo United (NTU)\*\*
  - \*\*4. South Taekwondo United (STU)\*\*
  - \*\*5. West Taekwondo United (WTU)\*\*
- \*\*B. Role of Associates\*\*
  - Each associate organizes regional training camps.
  - Funds raised are used to support standout athletes within their own region.
- \*\*C. Contributions to UTA\*\*
  - Each associate will give \$20 per affiliated club and \$10 per athlete (2 day camp) \$5 (1 day camp) attending the training camps to UTA.
  - These funds help cover taxes, promotion, advertising, website and remains are saved for awards at a global level example prestigious events.

#### \*\*III. Programs and Activities\*\*

- \*\*A. Training Camps\*\*
  - Regularly hosted by each associate to improve athlete skills, foster unity, and help the region grow in all aspects.
- \*\*B. Financial Support\*\*
  - Funds raised at the regional level are used to support athletes from that specific region. Each Associate has their own funds. Example GTU raised funds is to help GTU affiliated athletes only.
  - Global-scale awards and support provided through funds collected by UTA. Example UTA funds helps all the associates

- \*\*A. Importance of Affiliated Clubs\*\*
  - Serve as the foundation of UTA's mission and movement.
  - Believe in and promote the organization's motto.

- **\*\*B. Roles and Responsibilities\*\***
  - Voting rights within their respective associate on training schedules and athlete selection.
  - Eligibility for additional funding for athletes from affiliated clubs.
  - Affiliated Clubs will receive banner for 1st year, certificate for 2nd year , Flag for 3rd year , plaque for 4th year.
    - All affiliated clubs will be added to the Website.
    - Recieve shoutouts on social media platforms.
    - They will also have a vote on the structure of the trainings along with leading a segment if they choose too.

- **\*\*A. Regional Fund Distribution\*\***
  - Funds raised by each associate are awarded to athletes in their region.
- **\*\*B. UTA Fund Allocation\*\***
  - \$20 per affiliated club and \$10 per athlete from training camps are allocated to UTA.
  - These funds are used to cover taxes, promotion, website, advertising, and are saved to support athletes globally.

  - UTA is committed to ensuring that financial limitations do not hinder an athlete's potential.
